

RESOLUTION 19-24

To Authorize the Execution of a Contract for Trash Collection and Disposal Services

Summary

District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) requires a qualified firm to provide all necessary labor, materials, supplies, equipment and supervision to maintain uninterrupted trash collection and disposal services across various DCHA properties.

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the Executive Director to enter into a contract for trash collection and disposal services with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. for a period of five (5) years, in the aggregate amount of Four Million Five Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$4,552,173.00), subject to the availability of funding.

TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) requires trash collection and disposal services at various properties;

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2019, DCHA advertised a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) in *The Washington Post*, *The Washington Times*, *Afro American*, *The Current Newspaper*, *The Washington Informer*, *Hill Rag*, *El Tiempo Latino* and *East of the River*. Copies were emailed to all District Government Certified Business Entity members and all District of Columbia Department of Housing and Community Development (“DHCD”) Section 3 vendors;

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2019, Solicitation No. 0020-2019 Trash Collection and Disposal Services was issued to the Department of Small and Local Business Development, bidders interested in doing business with DCHA, posted to the DCHA Website and issued directly to six (6) firms;

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2019 DCHA hosted a pre-proposal conference, and eight (8) interested firms attended;

WHEREAS, by May 31, 2019, DCHA received three (3) proposals for evaluation;

WHEREAS, the solicitation stated that DCHA would make an award to the company that was deemed technically qualified in accordance with the solicitation requirements for trash collection and disposal services and in the best interest of DCHA;

WHEREAS, based on the proposal and the results of the evaluation process, DCHA determined that Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. has met the technical requirements of the RFP as a qualified firm capable of providing the required trash collection and disposal services for DCHA at various properties; and

WHEREAS, DCHA performed a review of the Federal Systems Award Management and the District’s Excluded Parties List on June 21, 2019, and has determined that Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. does not appear on that list.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of District of Columbia Housing Authority hereby authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract with Jerome L. Taylor Trucking, Inc. to provide Trash Collection and Disposal Services, for a period of five (5) years, in the aggregate amount of Four Million Five Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$4,552,173.00), subject to the availability of funding.
