The District of Columbia Housing Authority (DCHA) is providing notice of a Public Hearing to discuss and solicit comments on an amendment to the agency's 2017 Moving to Work (MTW) Plan related to a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Rental Assistance Demonstration initiative AND the agency's proposed 2018 MTW Plan. The Public Hearing will take place on Thursday, June 22, 2017 at 6:00 PM at 1133 North Capitol St., NE in the 2nd floor Board Room. The MTW program is a HUD program that allows select public housing authorities to design and implement innovative programs and policies with the intent to: 1) reduce costs and improve efficiencies; 2) encourage residents to obtain employment and become economically self-sufficient; and 3) increase housing choices for low-income families.
