

# RESOLUTION 19-31

To Approve the Acceptance of HUD Capital Fund Grant for Lead Hazards Clean Up in the District of Columbia Housing Authority, Grant #: DC39L00150119

## Summary

In accordance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), the District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) submitted a proposal for a HUD grant award of \$1,000,000 in Capital Funds to DCHA to support the identification and reduction of lead based paint hazards in agencies with older public housing units. DCHA was awarded this grant by HUD in the amount of \$1,000,000 to be utilized for lead remediation efforts at two properties: Highland Addition and Benning Terrace.

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia Housing Authority (DCHA) has received notice from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) of a Capital Funds grant award totaling \$1,000,000 for Lead Paint Clean up;

WHEREAS, the DCHA award of Capital Fund Plan has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the MTW Agreement;

WHEREAS, the \$1,000,000 award will be used for lead remediation at the following DCHA sites;

Benning Terrace and  
Highland Additions

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the District of Columbia Housing Authority hereby: 1) approves the acceptance of the Capital Fund award of \$1,000,000 for lead remediation; and 2) authorizes the DCHA Executive Director to execute and submit to HUD all required certifications and forms related to the award of the \$1,000,000 in Capital Funds for Lead Paint Hazards clean up at Highland Additions and Benning Terrace.
