

# RESOLUTION 19-35

## To Authorize Modifications for Environmental Initiative Contracts

### **Summary**

District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) requires qualified firms to provide perform environmental testing across various DCHA properties.

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the Executive Director to enter into contract modifications with qualified firms to provide these services in the aggregate amount of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00), subject to the availability of funding.

**TO AUTHORIZE MODIFICATIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVE  
CONTRACTS**

WHEREAS, District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) requires contractors to perform environmental testing;

WHEREAS, DCHA competitively procured contractors certified by the District Department of Energy and the Environmental for these services;

WHEREAS, DCHA needs to increase the maximum contract amounts with these firms in order to complete additional lead-based paint testing to guide DCHA with respect to lead abatement;

WHEREAS, DCHA proposes to allocate \$400,000 in additional contract authority among the four Risk Assessment contractors, as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of District of Columbia Housing Authority hereby authorizes the Executive Director to execute contract modifications with ARC Environmental, Quad3 Group, Connor Solutions, Total Environmental Concepts for Risk Assessments and Environmental Testing, subject to the availability of funding.
